5th Sunday of Lent

Focus: As we proceed in our Lenten pilgrimage, today we are enriched by the unforgettable example of Jesus who offers his forgiveness and restores dignity to the adulterous woman who had been dragged in front of him in shame and fear. The selfless and compassionate act of the Lord reminds us of the hope that is within us, as baptized Christians. That hope, however, was, and is, never just wishful thinking. It is hope that is active, responsible, and committed. The challenging sentence says it all: "Let the one among you who has no sin be the first to cast a stone." It is not directed only to the hypocritical scribes and Pharisees of two thousand years ago. It is meant also for those among us who easily judge and condemn others. We should never forget that we, too, are frail and sinful, and that we must learn to be merciful if we want to enjoy God's mercy. It takes effort and good will to be merciful like the Lord. In this Jubilee Year, we follow Paul's counsel for us "pilgrims of hope" ... we strain forward to what lies ahead!



Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope invites us to recall that as missionary disciples, we are to share our hope in Jesus Christ with others. There are many examples in our Dioceses of parish ministries that share this hope in their communities and beyond. One parish started making rosaries for the penitentiary chaplains to distribute, and now, along with the rosary making, they are going to the prison to pray the rosary with the men. Another parish's CWL has run a Thrift Store for over 50 years. Another parish has a very active pastoral care ministry that, as one of its outreaches, works with the palliative care director at its local hospital, bringing around a comfort cart for patients and families. Another parish has hosted meals for local first responders to appreciate their service in the community. There are many ways to be pilgrims of hope in our communities. Below are some suggestions particular to this Jubilee developed by different Diocesan Commission.




