DEVELOPMENT & PEACE in Nigeria

Nigeria is an African country on the Gulf of Guinea. The country has many natural landmarks and wildlife reserves. There are waterfalls, dense rainforests, savanna, and rare primate habitats.

Nigeria is a multinational state inhabited by more than 250 ethnic groups speaking 500 distinct languages. Nigeria has many natural resources including oil, coal, gypsum, gold, iron ore, zinc. Nigeria's top agricultural products are maize, guinea corn, and yams. They export sesame seeds, cashew nuts, and a superior quality of raw cocoa beans. In Nigeria, many farm lands have been contaminated by the oil industry. The rights enshrined in UNDROP provide pathways for peasants in Nigeria to enjoy nature, and to live in dignity. They expect Canada to make laws to hold the companies accountable and prevent them from polluting their environments.


