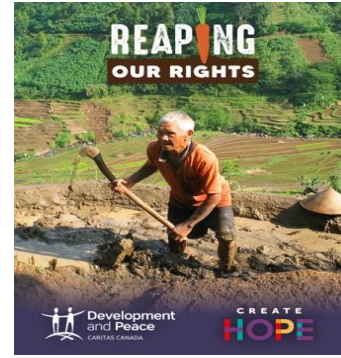
COLDEST NIGHT OF THE YEAR
