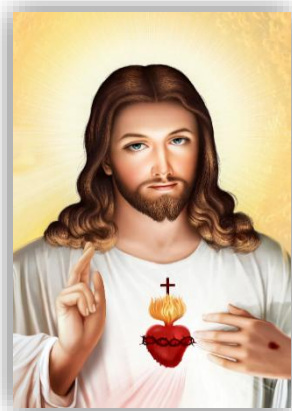

Sacramental Team

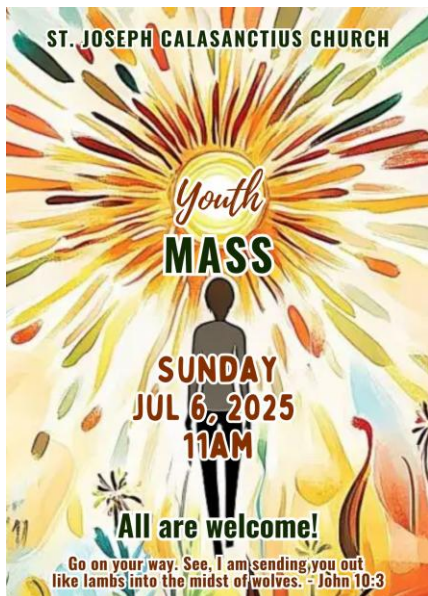
