## St. Joseph's Social Justice committee

is holding a **FOOD DRIVE** with collection on the weekend of Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>.

Battlefords District Food & Resource Centre is helping over 2,150 people per month; 53% of those are children.

In the last 6 months, 440 new people accessed the food bank. 19% of families are living on disability. The following list is the most needed: canned soup, beans, stews, chili, vegetables, fruit, meat, pasta, tomato sauce as well as peanut butter, jam, honey, pancake mix, cereal, oatmeal, dried pasta, rice, baby formula, diapers size 5 & 6, personal hygiene products, household cleaners, and water bottles. They also accept fresh produce but it must be dropped off directly at the food bank back door (1171 - 101st Street, North Battleford).


