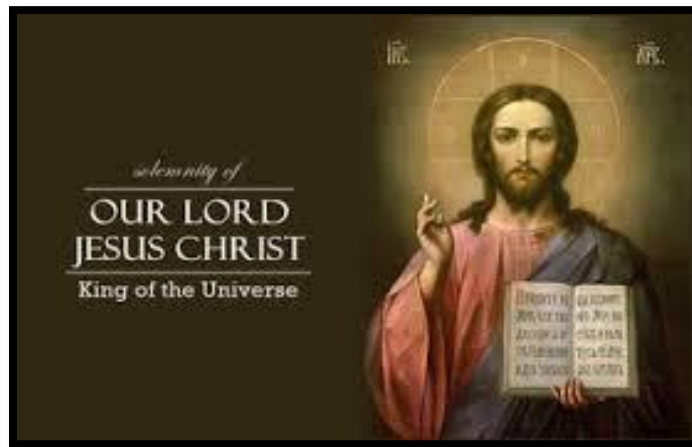

- Proof of Income: Paycheque Stub or Social Services Cheque total needs stub or Student Loan Statement or Employment Insurance Stub AND Child Tax Benefit Statement, Child support, Bank Statement.
- Proof of Expenses: Power, Energy, Water Bill. Rent Receipt, Childcare Receipt
- **Identification:** Health Cards, Driver's License. If you are not receiving child tax for children in your care, proof that they reside with you will be required

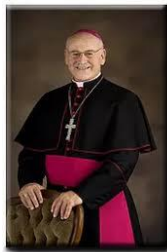
AUTO-DEBIT

- During the Communion Rite please proceed beginning from the south side of the church to the north, section by section.
- When offered the Holy Eucharist please say amen silently in your heart and open your hand fully to make distribution as efficient for Father as possible.

We are extremely happy to see you all here and to share this mass with you. Let's continue to work together to keep everyone safe.
